### Getting around...

Buses run from East Mersea during the summer holidays, however outside of this time buses will run from the other side of the island (West Mersea High Street), the number 63 goes into Colchester. For Colchester there is a park and ride option which allows you to hop on and off any park & ride bus all day.
